His lecture will cover: the different types of parkinsonism, the relationship between dementia and PD, and new research in PD.

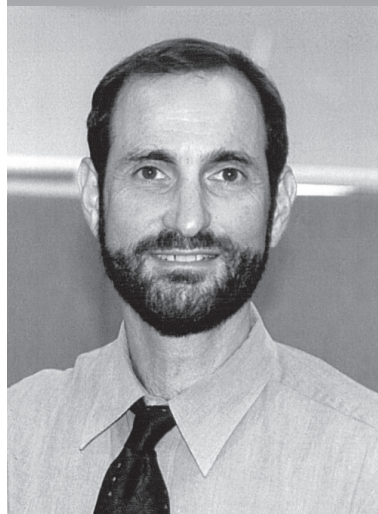
Come prepared with questions you may have regarding Parkinson's disease, as Dr. Perlmutter always takes questions following his presentation and will be happy to answer these following the lecture.
